Prolactin (PRL)	Stimulates milk production
Human Growth Hormone (HGH)	Stimulates growth
Thyroid Stimulating Hormone (TSH)	Stimulates thyroxin production in thyroid
Adrenocorticotrophic Hormone (ACTH)	Stimulates adrenal corticosteriod production
Luteinizing Hormone (LH)	Starts ovulation, maintains corpus luteum
Follicle Stimulating Hormone (FSH)	Stimulates growth & development of Graafin follicles
Melanin Stimulating Hormone (MSH)	Stimulates production of melanin
Gonadotrophins	Stimulates development of secondary sex characteristics
Interstitial Cell Stimulating Hormone (ICSH)	Stimulates sperm production in seminiferous tubules of the testes
Intermedin	Controls melanocyte production
